

## **Beggars Roost Dahlias 2024**

**These are divisions potted up in 2litres and just beginning to show life. They can be collected from here or delivered to the Group sale on the 27<sup>th</sup>. £3,50 a pot, cheque or cash on collection.**

**Classic Summertime (Misc).** Back of border height usually, Dark leaves. Really clear rather acid yellow



**Crediton Russet, Crediton Mauve.** Originally nameless plants given me by couple in Crediton who were retiring from their cut-flower shop, so given nursery names here. Both very good doers which flower lavishly



**Honka Red (SinO)** A slightly shorter dahlia with stiff stems holding the unusual flowers very stylishly. Tone of red may vary a little, some being darker red. In the photo the red double behind the Honka Red display is **Murdoch ambig. (D)**, a really venerable dahlia variety. Short-stemmed so not good for cutting, but long-flowering and a sturdy border plant with gorgeous colour



**York and Lancaster (D)** There are many stories and names connected with this plant, suggesting origins in Somerset, Dorset and France. Sometimes called **War of the Roses** but for some forgotten reason I've always stuck to the Y&L version. Both are listed in the RHS Plant Finder. Flowers can be red, white, or bi-coloured, all on the same plant, and are excellent cut flowers. A substantial plant with large plain green leaves so better for cutting bed than border
