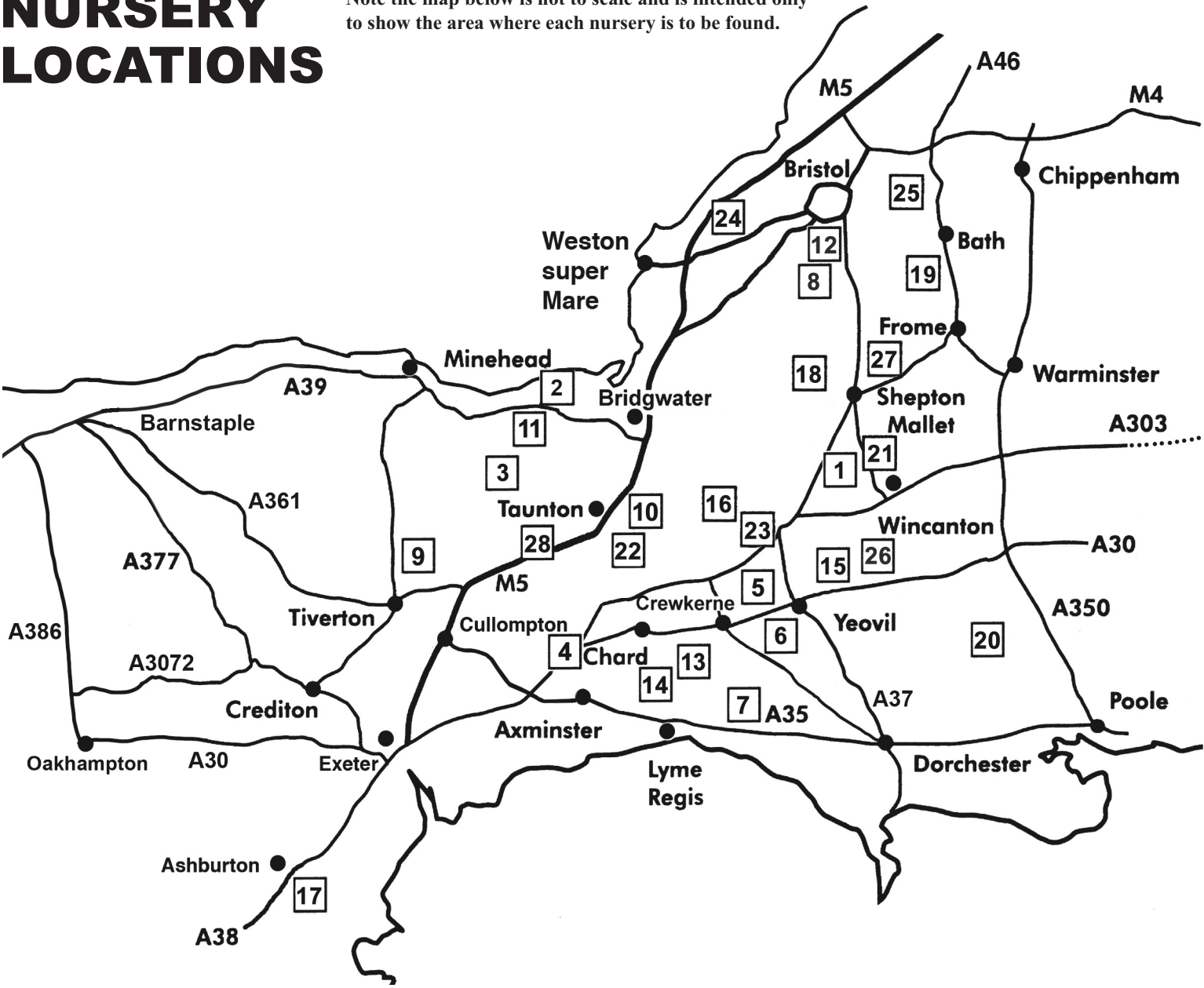

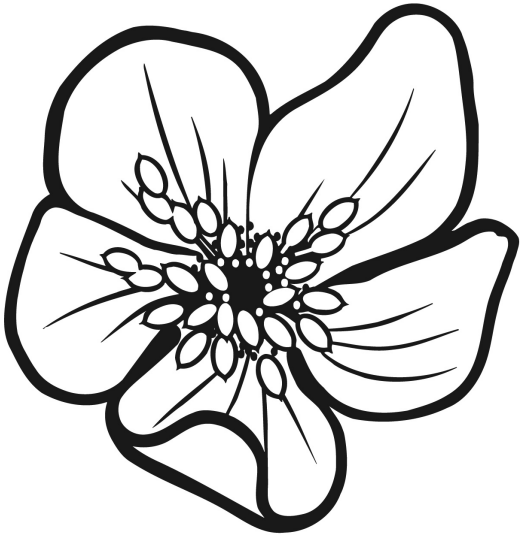
NURSERY LOCATIONS

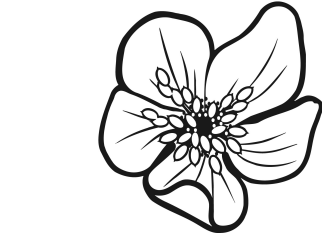




